Challenges

Adlai E. Stevenson High School (SHS) prides itself on its reputation as one of the best high schools in the country with approximately 98% of SHS graduates attending college.

Challenges and objectives for implementing a Transaction System included:

- Accommodating a large student body
- Wanting to emulate college experience for K-12 students
- Maintaining economically disadvantaged students’ privacy in relation to being enrolled into the free or reduced lunch program

Solution

Stevenson implemented a fully-integrated Transaction System that incorporates point-of-sale, vending, real-time mobile transactions, web deposits, and events.

Results
